SPECIAL EXHIBITION "BRITISH FORCES IN BERLIN" AT THE BLÜCHER KASERNE

The Sanitätsregiment 1 at the Blücher Kaserne in Berlin presents almost 50-year's history of the presence of the British Forces in Berlin. The exhibition includes many objects related to the military and everyday history of the British Regiments and other units in the city. For the first time an exhibition is dealing exclusively with the British Forces in Berlin.

The exhibition is presented on the compound of the Blücher Kaserne and opened last year for special visitor groups.

The tour will be led by Thomas Korn, the Co-Curator of the exhibition and the tour will be in English, lasting approximately 60 minutes. Due to limited access and restrictions the maximum number for a tour is 10 people. Therefore Thomas Korn offers two tours: One at 11.00 and one at 12.15. **Due to military restrictions we need the name, the nationality and the No. of the passport/Ausweis of all participants 3 days before the tour starts.
