**PROF JASON LANTZER - "AFTER NUREMBERG - THE OTHER TRIALS"
AND
BERND VON KOSTKA - "DENAZIFICATION"**

On 13 May we are offering a double-billing. Our principal speaker will be Prof Jason Lantzer from Butler University, Indiana. The subject of his talk will be "*The Other Trials - Seeking justice beyond the International Military Tribunal trials at Nuremberg.*" Whilst the proceedings and outcome of the Nuremberg trials are well-known, much less is known about the trials of other, less prominent, war criminals.

Jason's talk will be preceded by a short introduction from Bernd von Kostka, a senior curator at the Allied Museum, who will talk about Allied (especially US) Denazification in Germany/Berlin in general. The title of his talk will be: "*Denazification as a Goal of the German Occupation*". In 2015, Bernd was the curator of a special exhibition at the Allied Museum entitled "*Who was a Nazi?*"

Please join us for the talks, followed by a short question and answer session. There will be a reception of drinks and nibbles in the foyer of the library afterwards.
